I. The Scholarships

- Academic scholarships are available to eligible students on undergraduate and graduate levels, for any field including broadcast journalism and labor relations studies.
- Performing arts scholarships are also available. Recipients must be accepted by an
 accredited performing arts institution. These scholarships are <u>not</u> awarded for
 individual coaching or study with private teachers.
- 3. Scholarship winners are selected by the Scholarship Committee of the Foundation.
- Winners of scholarships may attend any accredited college or university in the United States, selecting there any course of study which leads to a Bachelor's or advanced degree.
- 5. Awards will be determined in June or July. Each scholarship award will become effective when the winner has sent proof of enrollment in the college to which he/she has been admitted.
- 6. In order to be considered in the competition for a scholarship for the upcoming academic year, applicant must complete the application form and provide all other required information and send them by <u>May 1st</u> to: The George Heller Memorial Scholarship Fund of the AFTRA Foundation, 260 Madison Avenue, 7th Floor, New York, New York, 10016.
- 7. We regret that grants cannot be renewed.

II. Eligibility

 An applicant for a scholarship must be an AFTRA member or the <u>dependent</u> child of an AFTRA member in good standing for at least five years, or the <u>dependent</u> child of a deceased member who, at the time of death, was an AFTRA member in good standing for at least five years.

- Applicants must show both a high level of academic achievement and financial need since the limited number of available scholarships will be awarded on a strictly competitive basis. The amount of the individual award will depend upon the financial need of the family and the availability of funds; it may be for less but cannot now be for more than \$2500.
- 3. The applicant must send a fully completed application form plus <u>all</u> other required information by May 1st.

III. Application Guidelines

- 1. In order for an application to be considered, it must include:
 - a. A fully completed application form, typewritten or <u>legibly</u> handwritten by the applicant. Any and all material must be clearly identified in the upper right-hand corner with the full name of the applicant on whose behalf it is being sent (including IRS returns, etc.).
 - b. The original essay described in the application form. Please be <u>sure</u> to observe the prescribed length for the essay.
 - Your high school or college transcript, which may be sent separately by the school or college. Please ask for it <u>in time</u> so that it is received by us no later than May 1st;
 - d. Two letters of recommendation, which must be received by us no later than **May** 1st
 - e. To determine an applicant's financial need, the following:
 - i. A complete copy of applicant's last Federal tax return, including all supplemental schedules and forms.
 - ii. A complete copy of the last Federal tax return, including all supplemental schedules and forms of the parent, guardian, or other person who claims applicant as a dependent;
 - iii. In the instance of divorce or separation, a complete copy of the last Federal tax return, including all supplemental schedules and forms, of parent or guardian having custody;
 - iv. A statement describing financial support (child support and mandatory obligations to defray educational expenses), if any, given by a divorced or separated parent.

All information will be held in strict confidence.

2. Please note:

- a. Read the requirements carefully. Be sure you are eligible;
- b. Your financial need and academic excellence are the primary criteria;
- c. Your academic transcript and <u>all</u> supporting material are carefully considered;
- d. Neatness, spelling and grammar are important and do count;
- e. No application will be considered without <u>all</u> required information received in a timely fashion;
- f. Please enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope

N.B.: These scholarships are funded solely by voluntary tax-deductible contributions; they are not funded by the dues of AFTRA members.
