Subject of Review:	Rapid expansion of global biofuel production raises questions of its sustainability. The outlook for biofuels to secure a more significant role as a global transportation fuel will depend on a number of interrelated factors, including the future price of oil, the availability of plentiful low-cost biomass, supportive policy, the commercialization of second generation biofuels, and competition from unconventional fossil fuel alternatives. This report is based on a broad review of literature covering global analyses of biofuel developments as well as developments in the most important producing and consuming countries in the world. This report is based on the 2006 PECC report, The Future Role of Biofuels. Since that report focused only on the Asia-Pacific region and primarily on ethanol the most important biofuel in that region, additional analyses were undertaken to add biodiesel and other parts of the world, most importantly the EU, the world's leading producer of biodiesel. Special attention was given to providing perspective to the intersection of agricultural and energy markets, important to assessing the extent to which biofuels are meeting energy security goals.
