The removal of tobacco <br> price supports did away with minimal prices for tobacco and the assurance of a <br> guaranteed buyer, while quota eradication allowed producers to plant any amount or <br> type of tobacco without regard to their geographical location. This report uses data <br> collected from the tobacco version of the 2008 Agricultural Resource and <br> Management Survey (ARMS) to track the adjustments made by the 2008 tobacco <br> producers in response to the tobacco buyout. Comparisons are then made between <br> the adjustments made by burley and flue-cured tobacco producers. |
