Subject of Review:	The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Economic Research Service (ERS) has served as a source of major land use estimates in the United States for over 50 years. The major land-use series is the only consistent accounting of all major uses of land in the United States, public and private. Economic analyses often require consistent acreage estimates of land use. Prior to 1945, area estimates of major land uses were not consistently available for all States and all major uses of land. Various agencies had data on land use that differed widely in definition, collection criteria, and acreage. No single agency provided all land uses that would sum to the total land in the United States. This publication presents the results of the latest (2007) inventory of U.S. major land uses, drawing on data from the Census Bureau, public land management and conservation agencies, and other sources. The data are synthesized by State to calculate the use of several broad classes and subclasses of agricultural and nonagricultural land over time.
