Subject of Review:	This report uses nationally representative school-level data from SNDA to calculate statistical differences between the fat content of NSLP lunches served by schools and (a) school policies and (b) school characteristics. Schools were divided into three categories based on the average fat content of reimbursable school lunches served and chosen by students over a week. The fat content categories are: (1) no more than 30 percent of calories from fat; (2) 30 to 35 percent of calories from fat; and (3) more than 35 percent of calories from fat. The report compares the policy usage and characteristics of schools within each fat categories.
