It is challenging for participating local school food authorities (SFAs) to serve appealing, healthful meals while covering food, labor, and other operating costs with USDA reimbursements. But it may be more difficult for some SFAs than others due to cost differences across locations. Using data from the School Food Authority Characteristics survey conducted in 2003-2004, the study employs an econometric approach to measure the effects of location on total school food service costs, while controlling for other SFA characteristics. |
