About the Collection Management Initiative

The Collection Management Initiative is a UC-wide research project funded by the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation. From October 2001 through September 2002, selected print journals in UC libraries for which electronic access is available through the California Digital Library, will be temporarily removed from the shelf. During the study, library users will rely primarily on the electronic version of these journals. If a library user needs to consult the print version, the volume will be temporarily brought back for use or a photocopy will be provided. Usage data will be gathered, and user experiences and preferences will be assessed. After evaluating the study results, the University will use what has been learned to develop strategies, policies and programs for the future management of library collections consisting of both digital and print formats.
